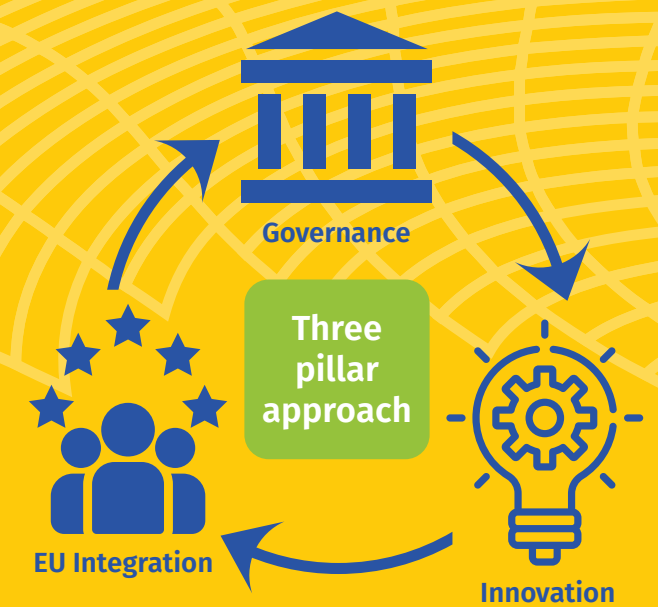

Legal Approach

- Highly centralized (1 law): Albania, Greece
- Neutral (3 laws): Bosnia Herzegovina
- Fragmented (>3 laws): Croatia, Italy, Montenegro, Slovenia



Governance approach

- Top-down: Albania, Montenegro, Slovenia
- Both top-down & bottom-up: Bosnia Herzegovina, Croatia, Greece, Italy



Governance system organization

- Centralized: Albania, Croatia, Slovenia
- Rather centralized: Greece
- Rather decentralized: Montenegro, Italy
- Decentralized: Bosnia Herzegovina
